
The Jim Tate Open - A friendly round of golf for all levels.

Course Info

Aspects of Future-Proof Endodontics

Endodontic therapy has been defined as treatment or prevention of apical periodontitis. However, the purpose of endodontic therapy could be seen as to aid in retaining teeth for a lifetime. This goal may be obvious, but perhaps occasionally at odds with the task of complete resolution of inflammation. There is no shortage in technology, such as innovative instruments, wireless devices, and novel microscope attachments. Moreover, advances in the biologic understanding, for example in stem-cell based regenerative therapy, are promising changes in clinical practice. However, all this must be viewed with patient outcomes in mind.

Collectively, this series of talks aims to highlight relevant aspects for clinicians engaged in endodontic practice. First, this course will interactively discuss clinical cases and decision-making and highlight restorative aspects of case outcomes. Then using the four main steps in non-surgical root canal treatment, namely access, cleaning and shaping, obturation and post-endodontic care, relevant in vitro and clinical data will be discussed in detail.

Objectives:

- Differentiate endodontic outcomes including local and overall health implications
- Discuss current controversies in root canal treatment, including but not limited to, single-cone obturation and minimal invasive endodontics
- List and critically evaluate contemporary standards of practice for clinical endodontics and restorative care

At the conclusion of each seminar attendees should be able to understand and have full knowledge of each of the objectives listed below each course. No prior knowledge or skill level is required before attending these courses.

Dentists who attend all three courses will earn a total of 11.5 CEUs.

Each continuing education activity is presented in a lecture format, with audio-visual accompaniment and an opportunity for questions.

Speaker Bio



Dr. Ove A. Peters joined the Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry in San Francisco in 2007 after holding faculty positions in Heidelberg, Germany and Zurich, Switzerland, as well as at the University of California, San Francisco. He received his postgraduate education in endodontics at the University of Zurich and at UCSF and is certified as a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics. At Pacific he is a tenured professor and currently the co-chair as well as the director of the Advanced Education Program in Endodontology.

Dr. Peters has wide-ranging research expertise and has published more than 150 manuscripts and abstracts related to endodontic technology and biology. He has authored two books, has contributed to several leading textbooks, and is an associate editor for the International Endodontic Journal and serves on the review panel of several dental journals. Dr. Peters has received the Hans Genet Award of the European Society of Endodontology and more recently the Louis I. Grossman Award of the American Association of Endodontists. He is a member of OKU as well as Fellow of the International and American Colleges of Dentistry.

His main scientific interests are the design and performance of root canal instruments. In this area Dr. Peters has developed novel methods of three-dimensional imaging and mechanical testing. He has also assessed the efficacy of antimicrobial regimes in root canal treatment. More recently he became involved in research in endodontic and stem cell biology.
