

# Course Info

## **Anatomically Driven Endodontics/New Technologies/Complex Cases** (Thursday)

The presentation will start with a brief endo/implant discussion followed by the discussion of complex anatomy and the latest in irrigation protocol. Successful endodontic treatment outcome is a healthy apical periodontium and long-term survival of the tooth. These objectives are achieved by meticulous disinfection of the root canal space, avoiding excessive removal of dentin, and optimal sealing of the root canal and coronal spaces.

The 3-dimensional XP family of endodontic instruments has been modeled to achieve a fusion of technology and biology that integrates all variables essential for predictable endodontic success.

The super elasticity and shape-memory of the alloy used in XP instruments facilitates expansion and adaptation into canal morphology where traditional round NiTi files are unable to reach with any margin of safety. This enables maximal debridement and disinfection without changes to the original canal shape and ensures minimal removal of intra-canal dentin. This ultra-conservative root treatment can then be filled using bioceramic technologies that do not require excessive preparation in the coronal component of the root canal space to accommodate obturation procedures.

Also to be discussed is diagnosis and treatment of cracked teeth and how the CBCT technology has revolutionized our ability to interpret things in 3 dimensions. There will be several complex cases shown and brief discussion about removal of separated instruments and other trouble shooting techniques.

At the conclusion, the attendees should be able to:

- Comprehend the scientifically based biologic requirements for endodontic success.
- Be cognizant and comfortable with the latest generation of technologies in endodontics to clinically obtain the essential biologic goals for success.
- Diagnose and treat complex cases.
- Identify and troubleshoot mishaps that may occur.

# Speaker Bio



**Dr. Samuel Kratchman** received a B.S. in Biology and D.M.D. at Tufts University in Boston, and his certificate in endodontics from the University of Pennsylvania, where he is an Associate Professor of Endodontics and Assistant Director of Graduate Endodontics, in charge of microsurgery.

Dr. Kratchman co-authored the textbook of Endodontic Microsurgery with Dr. Kim published in 2017 and developed a patented instrument called the S Kondenser for obturation of root canals. Both Main Line Today and Doctor of Dentistry magazines honored Dr. Kratchman as the cover story for their "Best of" issues. Dr. Kratchman lectures nationally and internationally.

## **Endodontic Microsurgery and Management of Complications** (Friday/Saturday)

Performing apical surgery has become much more predictable due to the new technology in endodontics, involving the operating microscope, microsurgical instruments, the CBCT, as well as the latest generation of Bioceramic root end filling materials. The lecture will cover all the major aspects of endodontic surgery, from case selection to armamentarium and show each step for performing successful apical surgery. We will show hemostatic agents and Bioceramics, which are the new generation of bio-compatible root end filling materials, as well as discussing important clinical tips like patient/microscope positioning and access to difficult areas, such as palatal surgery and surgery involving the sinuses. We will also discuss safe management of the mental nerve. Many clinical cases will be shown, utilizing these techniques, as well as a series of cases using various bone grafting and guided tissue membrane materials. Success rates/prognosis with current surgical techniques will be discussed, as well as the endodontic surgery versus implant dilemma.

At the conclusion, the attendees should be able to:

- Describe case selection and discuss when to do surgery versus conventional retreatment.
- Explain proper positioning of microscope/patient/doctor.
- Identify and troubleshoot potential complications involving the mental nerve and sinuses and palatal roots.
- Explain manipulation and placement of Bioceramic root end filling.
- Describe management of endo/perio lesions.

## **Intentional Replantation** (Saturday)

What was once considered a procedure of last resort can now be included into one's everyday treatment planning in describing the new techniques versus the way replantations used to be performed, the goal of the lecture is for everyone to become confident doing this procedure. The importance of proper case selection will be discussed along with a step-by-step technique, offering tips to success. There will be many clinical cases shown, proving this to be a predictable procedure. Saving our patient's natural teeth should still be the goal of an dentist/endodontists.

At the conclusion, the attendees should be able to:

- Describe proper case selection and treatment planning.
- Explain techniques and instruments to remove teeth without fracturing
- Recite the success rates and benefits to retaining natural teeth
- Explain and include replantation in your treatment modalities.
