<u>Call to Order</u> - Dr. Brown called the meeting to order at 12:09 p.m.

<u>Welcome and Introduction of Guests</u> - Dr. Brown thanked everyone for being there and introduced Mr. Gary Rejebian, AAE Foundation.

Day 1

From Files to Ferrule: A Restoratively Driven Path to Endodontic Excellence

This course focuses on the extension of the tooth life cycle. Participants will learn the benefits of reviewing Remaining Dentin Thickness (RDT) and current endodontic restorative trends/techniques that preserve longterm success of the tooth. The goal of this course is to reinforce the value of combining Endo/Resto and the need to retain Pericervical Dentin and the establishment of a "TruFerrule".

Day 2

When to Retain the Compromised Tooth a Microsurgical Endodontic Perspective: **Procedures to Enhance Patient Centered Outcomes**

Clinicians are often faced with challenges in diagnosing endodontically treated teeth that may require surgery to assist in rubber dam isolation, apical surgery and/or intentional replantation.



Day 3

Endodontic Retreatment versus Endodontic Surgery: Decision Planning Dilemmas

As clinicians, we are often presented with endodontic cases that persist with symptoms or become re-infected. But what are the parameters that should be considered before we decide to manage the case by either endodontic re-treatment or endodontic surgery? This will be both a "why to" presentation focusing on the decision-making process and a "how to" presentation. We hope this stimulates participant conversations and opinions through an Audience Response System (ARS).
